We are seeking demonstrators to attend who are proficient in earthskills as well as artisans who use natural resources to create beautiful, earth related crafts. These might include, basketry, flint knapping, cordage, woodcarving, blacksmithing, medicinal plants, salt making, beadwork, felting, weaving, etc. In addition to demonstrating, you may bring your wares to sell to our attendees, with our approval. This is a volunteer opportunity (unless prior arrangements have been made) to promote your skills/crafts as well as connect attendees to nature in a much deeper way through almost forgotten traditional trades. There is no charge for your participation. However, if you are moved to support TI by means of a donation, we would be honored. We hope you will consider joining us. Please fill out the application, submit it to us and we will get back to you. Important information to know:

- You may bring 1 additional helper at no charge. Additional helpers will need to purchase an admission ticket.
- Lunch will be available for purchase or you may bring your own on Saturday.
- If you opt to come Friday evening to set up and spend the night, a simple dinner on Friday evening and a simple breakfast on Saturday morning will be provided.

- Set up will be from 4:00 - 6:00 on Friday evening, May 3, or from 7:30- 9:00 on Saturday morning May 4. All vehicles must be parked and your area ready to go by 9:30 on Saturday morning. Please do not begin breaking down your area until 3:30. On Saturday afternoon.
- The event will be held rain or shine. By signing this agreement you agree to appear rain or shine as well. No last minute cancellations due to weather. As we are counting on you.
- We have limited primitive housing/camping availability for Friday evening on a first come first serve basis. Please let us know if you will need accommodations.
- Liability forms must be signed by each demonstrator.
- No smoking or drinking of alcoholic beverages is allowed on site.
- You will need to bring all tables, chairs and tenting needed for your area.
- No Wifi available. All purchases will be in cash/check. That is well publicized.
